CHEMICAL HYGIENE PLANS

Guiding Principle and Purpose

Promote the health and well-being of students and employees.

Policy

The RI School for the Deaf, when engaged in the laboratory use of hazardous chemicals, as that term is defined in the <u>Code of Federal Regulations</u>, 29 C.F.R. 1910.1450, shall maintain a written chemical hygiene plan that outlines the procedures, equipment, and work practices that are appropriate for protecting employees and students from avoidable chemical health hazards.
